EXTENDED ACCESS HUBS



During the month of March the SWGP Federation will complete it's roll out of Extended Access Hubs, taking the total up to **6 by 11th of March**.

New hubs at the Castle Medical Centre in Kenilworth and Southam Surgery in Southam opened on 4 February 2019. A further two hubs will open on 11 March 2019 at **Hastings House** in Wellesbourne and **Arrow Surgery** in Alcester.

Once the 6 Extended Access Hubs are in operation the total number of appointments available will increase to **796 per week** (compared to 532 available at present) taking us up to 45 minutes per 1000 patients.

The 6 hubs are located across South Warwickshire to ensure that they are accessible to patients living across the region.
